- Firewood, running water and porta pots will be located at the Lewisburg Park.
- The Lewisburg Historical Society Train Depot and the TCN Community Association building have restrooms, air conditioning and drinking fountains.
- For those of you who plan to have campfires, we ask that you remove the sod and set it aside. Please do not throw any trash in the fire pit. If it's dry, please have a fire bucket close by. Once you are finished for the weekend, please douse the fire to make sure it's out and put the sod back into place.

If you are participating in the Bicentennial Parade, the lineup begins at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 8th.

The Bicentennial Committee is providing a Thank You Dinner for all Campers, Re-enactors, Demonstrators, Vendors and Entertainers on Saturday at 6:00 p.m. in the covered bridge.
